Rules of Golf:

Question: May I use a Distance Measuring Device (DMD) during a competitive round of golf?

Answer: DMD's may only be used under the Rules of Golf if the committee makes a local rule allowing their use, at a particular course or tournament. See Rule 14-3 and the note at the end of the rule. A specimen local rule may be found on page 140 of the rulebook. Remember to check the local rules board before using DMD's during a round, as the penalty for a breach of rule 14-3 is Disqualification.
