Rules of Golf from our own class A referee: Glenn Corbett.

Question: If "Preferred Lies" or Placing is in force do I have to place in similar ground as my ball first lay?

Answer: No, as long as the ball lies within the allowed relief distance (eg. 15cm or one club length etc). The Ball must not be nearer the hole, or on the putting green or in a hazard. If the ball lay two inches on the fairway and you wanted to place it in the rough next to it, you can.

The above situation also applies to The Nearest Point of Relief if applicable under a relevant rule. The Nearest Point is just that, the Nearest Point. It could be on the fairway, in the rough, behind a tree or wherever as long as its the nearest point of relief from the situation in question. This occurred often during the recent Taranaki Open with casual water a common occurrence around the course, sometimes the players could be disadvantaged by having to drop in an unfavourable lie, and of course the opposite can also happen.

Vets Pennants:

Finals day was played on the 28th June at The NP Golf Club. The day was fine to start but soon deteriorated to a very wet unpleasant day with players having to putt on flooded greens at the end. Many teams did not finish out their rounds.
